

Privacy Notice

Who we are

1.1 We are Green Investing Systems, Ltd. (registered at prem. 240 BLACKFRIARS ROAD, LONDON, ENGLAND, SE1 8NW).

1.2 This Privacy Policy sets out how we collect and use your personal information when you visit green-investing.pw and the choices available to you in connection with our use of your personal information (the Privacy Policy). This Privacy Policy should be read alongside, and in addition to, our Site terms and conditions (accessible online at green-investing.pw/rules additional domain located at *.ltd, *.co.uk, *.digital) (User Agreement) and our Cookie Policy (accessible online at green-investing.pw/cookies additional domain located at *.ltd, *.co.uk, *.digital). In case of any contradictions between this Privacy Policy and the Terms, this Privacy Policy will prevail.

This Privacy Policy

2.1 By making available the Site and its services (hereinafter the Site Services) we, acting reasonably and in good faith, believe that you:

- (a) have all necessary rights to register on and use this Site;
- (b) provide true information about yourself to the extent necessary for use of the Site Services;
- (c) understand that by the posting your personal information you have manifestly made this information public, and this information may become available to other Site users and internet users, be copied and disseminated by them;
- (d) understand that some types of information transferred by you to other Site users cannot be deleted by you or us;
- (e) are aware of and accept this Privacy Policy.

2.2 We do not check the user information received from you, except where such check is necessary in order for us to fulfill our obligations to you.

2.3 This Privacy Policy applies only to the European Union-based users. If you are not a European Union-based user, please refer to the Privacy Policy applicable in the relevant jurisdiction.

Information we collect about you

3.1 In order to implement the agreement between you and us, and provide you with access to the use of the Site functionality, we will improve the Site Services, develop and implement new Site Services, and enhance available Site and services functionality. To achieve these objectives, and in compliance with applicable laws, we will collect, store, aggregate, organise, extract, compare, use, and supplement your data (hereinafter “processing”). We

will also receive and pass this data, and our automatically processed analyses of this data to our affiliates and partners as set out in the table below and section 4 of this Privacy Policy.

3.2 We set out in more detail the information we collect when you use our Site Services, why we collect and process it and the legal bases below.

1. Location Data

We use your location data in order to generate recommendations and tailor and improve the adverts that are presented on the Site. We also use this information in order to provide you with recommendations, community groups we feel you may be interested in, updates and information on our and selected third parties' products and services we think you may be interested in.

2. Data you provide for registering on the Site including your name, surname, date of birth, gender, mobile phone number and/or email

We use this information in order to manage and administer the Site including providing our services to you. We use this data to enable us to fulfill our obligations to you as part of the Site Services (e.g. in cases where you request restoration of your page that is not linked to a mobile phone number). See section 9.3 of this Privacy Policy for more information. We also use this information in order to provide you with recommendations, community groups we feel you may be interested in, updates and information on our and selected third parties' products and services we think you may be interested in. We use this information in order to generate recommendations and tailor and improve the adverts that are presented on the Site.

3. Where necessary, a copy of your identity or another document containing your name, surname, photography and number of the principal identity document of you or your representative. We may take additional verification steps where we consider reasonable in order to verify your account.

We use this data in order to verify your account and prevent abuse and infringements of your or other persons' rights. For example, we use this information to verify your identity if you lose your credentials and wish to access your account with us.

4. Additional data received when you access the Site, including information regarding technical devices, technical interaction with the Site (your host IP-address, your operating system, type of a browser, geographic position, your installed apps, the Internet provider, contacts from your phonebook, data obtained accessing the camera, microphone and similar devices) and your browsing behaviour and further actions on the Site.

We use your data for internal review in order to constantly improve the content of our web page, to understand any errors you may encounter when using the Site, to notify you of changes to the Site and to personalise the use of our Site. Information containing the Site activity history is available in the "Settings / Security" section of your page. We use this information in order to tailor and improve the adverts that are presented on the Site and measure the effectiveness of these advertisements.

5. Information that is created by you while placing requests to our Services support.

We use this information in order to verify your identity and to fulfil your support request. We may also use this data in order to investigate any complaints on your behalf and to provide you with a more efficient service.

6. Information that is received as the result of your using payment functionality on the Site (e.g. first and last four digits of your card number that are needed for the option of matching these details with user's id number).

We use this information in order to manage and administer the Site including providing our Site Services to you. We may also use this data in order to investigate any complaints on your behalf and to provide you with a more efficient service.

3.3 Our legitimate interests include (1) maintaining and administrating the Site; (2) providing the Site Services to you; (3) improving the content of the Site; (4) ensuring your account is adequately protected.

3.4 Your personal information may also be processed if it is required by a law enforcement or regulatory authority, body or agency or in the defence or exercise of legal claims. We will not delete personal information if it is relevant to an investigation or a dispute. It will continue to be stored until those issues are fully resolved and/or during the term that is required and/or permissible under applicable/relevant law.

3.5 You may withdraw your consent the collection of location data and your apps by amending your privacy settings on the Site or mobile app/the privacy settings of your mobile device.

3.6 Please note, if you withdraw your consent to processing or you do not provide the data that we require in order to maintain and administer the Site, you may not be able to access or register with the Site.

3.7 If we intend to further process your data for any other purpose to those set out in this Privacy Policy, we shall provide you with details of this further purpose before we commence processing.

Data sharing

4.1 With respect to the personal information of the User, confidentiality is maintained except in cases where the User voluntarily provides information about himself for general access to the unlimited persons.

4.2 The site has the right to transfer the personal information of the User to third parties in the following cases:

(a) The user has agreed to such actions.

(b) Transfer is necessary for the User to use a particular service or to execute a specific agreement or contract with the User

(c) In order to ensure the possibility of protecting the rights and legitimate interests of the Site or third parties in cases where the User violates the Site User Agreement or this Policy.

Privacy Settings

5.1 We bear no liability for the deliberate disclosure of User's Personal Data in accordance with applicable law.

5.2 The Site contains links to sites operated by third parties. We are not responsible for your data privacy when you access these links or engage with third party services.

5.3 We bear no liability for the actions of third parties which, as the result of your use of the internet or the Site Services, obtain access to your information.

International Transfers

6.1 We will retain your personal information for as long as required to perform the purposes for which the data was collected depending on the legal basis for which that data was obtained and/or whether additional legal/regulatory obligations mandate that we retain your personal information during the term that is required and/or permissible under applicable/relevant law.

6.2 You may delete your personal data by removing the data from your personal account.

Retention Periods

7.1 We may transfer and maintain on our servers or databases some of your personal information outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

7.2 The countries to which we transfer your data may not have the same data protection laws as your jurisdiction. We take reasonable cyber security measures and/or put in place the Standard Contractual Clauses (e.g. Model Clauses, Data Processing Agreement/Addendum) to ensure your data is adequately protected.

Your Rights

8.1 You have the following rights, in certain circumstances, in relation to your personal information:

- (a) Right to access your personal information.
- (b) Right to rectify your personal information, you can request that we update or delete your personal data.
- (c) Right to request that your personal information is erased.
- (d) Right to object to processing of your personal information.
- (e) Right to data portability (in certain specific circumstances).
- (f) Right not to be subject to an automated decision.
- (f) Right to lodge a complaint with a relevant supervisory authority.

8.2 You also have a right to independently remove your account and make changes and corrections to your personal account on the Site, provided that such changes and corrections contain up-to-date and true information.

Security Measures

9.1 We take technical, organizational and legal measures, including, where suitable, encryption, to ensure that your personal data are protected from unauthorized or accidental access, deletion, modification, blocking, copying and dissemination.

9.2 Access to the Site is authorized using your login and password. You are responsible for keeping this information confidential. You should not share your credentials with third parties and we recommend you take measures to ensure this information is kept confidential.

9.3 If you forget your login details, and we hold your email, you can ask us to send you an message which will contain a restoration code.

9.4 To reduce the probability of third parties gaining unauthorized access, if you login to your account from an unusual server (in particular, from a server located in a foreign country), we will block entry to your personal account.
